

Stringer finished his first full season with the Hurricanes in March, 2020. Zack appeared in a total of 14 games as a 15-year-old in the 2018-2019 season, netting seven points. The product of Lethbridge, Alberta was awarded the Lethbridge Hurricanes' rookie of the year award soon after the 2019-2020 season was complete, finishing with 34 points as a 16-year-old.

He played two seasons with the Lethbridge Hurricanes Midget AAA and collected 71 points in 53 games. In his first full season with the Lethbridge Hurricanes, and the eight games he played as an affiliate player he collected 38 points in 56 games. At what level of hockey did he collect the most points?

or

Tetachuk - Jones = Stringer







 - c. Zack played 9 games at U12, 9 games at U13, 7 games at U14, and 16 games at U15.



2.	Zack Stringer scored 45 goals in Bantam AAA, 31 goals in Midget AAA, and so far 12 goals in the WHL. What percentage of his career goals came at the Midget AAA level?
3.	In the 2018-19 season Zack Stringer finished third on his Midget AAA team in points with 41. Michael Horon finished first on that team with 61 points. However, since reaching the WHL Zack has recorded 38 points while Michael has only recorded 13. What percentage of Michael Horon's points did Zack Stringer have at the Midget AAA and WHL levels, respectively?
4.	In the 2019-20 season Zack Stringer played in 48 of the Hurricanes' 63 games. What percentage of the team's games did Zack play in?
