Today's Matchup: The Regina Pats host the Brandon Wheat Kings in the third game of the Pats six game homestand inside the Brandt Centre...the Pats have won their last three games while the Wheat Kings have dropped their last two and five of their last six contests heading into tonight's action.

Last Game: Regina 4, Moose Jaw 3...the Pats scored a season high three goals in the second period and held on in the third for their third straight win...Braxton Whitehead and Luke Bateman scored their first goals of the season while Zack Smith (1G-1A), Zack Stringer (1G-1A) and Tanner Howe (2A) each had multi-point games.

Coming Up: The Regina Pats continue their six game homestand tonight at the Brandt Centre...the Pats end their six game homestand with three games next week, as the Pats host the Red Deer Rebels for Remembrance Day on Wednesday, followed by contests against the Edmonton Oil Kings on Friday and Lethbridge Hurricanes on Saturday...the Pats then head on a five game road trip to end the month of November.

Headlines:

Opponent: The Brandon Wheat Kings are coming off a 5-3 loss at home against Red Deer on Friday, November 5th and have now dropped their last two games and five of their last six games since their three game winning-streak came to an end on October 22nd...the Wheat Kings currently have five players on the injured list, with most notably Ridly Greig and Vincent Iorio out with day-to-day upper body injuries.

Last season, the Regina Pats went 1-2-1-0 against the Wheat Kings, going to overtime in two of those four contests...the Pats won 2-1 in overtime, while losing 3-2 in overtime, 7-2 and 5-2...Brandon and Regina have faced off 459 times all-time coming into today's play...the Pats are 7-8-1-2 since the 2018-19 season, with 10 of those 18 games being decided by one goal.

The Regina Pats finished the month of October with a 4-7 record, tied for fourth in the Eastern Division with eight points, while outscored 33-to-38 in 11 games...Pats power play went 10-for-41 (24.4%) while the penalty kill was 45-for-58 (77.5%)...Cole Dubinsky and Ryker Evans were tied for first in points with 12 in October, while Dubinsky led in goals (7) and Evans led in assists (10).

Rookie forward Zane Rowan was named the Pats Academic Player of the Month for October...the 2004 born Lomita, CA, native is currently completing seven online grade 12 courses and is maintaining a 95.68 GPA.

Regina Pats defenceman Ryker Evans was named the week four WHL Player of the Week and as the only WHL player to be named to the CHL team of the week, scoring one goal and three assists, as well as a +6 rating in two games last weekend.

Pats By the Numbers:

- 12** Number of points (2G-10A) for Regina Pats defenceman Ryker Evans is tied for third amongst defencemen in the WHL, while his 10 assists ranks tied for fourth...the Calgary, AB, native also ranks tied for fourth among defencemen in power play points with six.
- 2** Straight multi-point games for Pats forward Tanner Howe...he scored a short-handed goal and an assist against Swift Current and two assists against Moose Jaw...he is one of three rookies to score a short-handed goal in the WHL, and has four points (1G-3A) over his last two games.
- 3** Straight wins for goaltender Matthew Kieper is a new career high...over his last three starts, the Winnipeg native has stopped 84 of 91, good for a 2.33 goals-against average and .923 save percentage...he is ranked a "C" level prospect by NHL Central Scouting.
- 165** Faceoff wins for Pats captain Logan Nijhoff is second best in the WHL behind of Prince Albert's Reece Vitelli (172)...he went 16-26 on the faceoff dot on Wednesday against Moose Jaw...he just had his career high five game point-streak come to an end last game (3G/3A).
- 68** Shots on goal for Regina Pats forward Connor Bedard leads the WHL...the Vancouver native is averaging 5.66 shots on net per contest this season and holds an 11.33% shooting percentage, along with six goals and 10 points in 12 games.

John Paddock | VP, Hockey Operations & General Manager

Bio: From Brandon, Manitoba...enters his eighth season with the Pats...fourth as GM & Director of Hockey Ops.

Coaching & Front office: Begins his 39th season working behind the bench or in a hockey front office (1983-present). Began his coaching career in the AHL with the Maine Mariners and Hershey Bears (1983-89) before joining the Philadelphia Flyers as an Assistant GM in 1989-90. He made his NHL Head Coaching debut in the 1991-92 season with the Winnipeg Jets, where he both coached (1991-95) and served as their GM (1995-96) before spending half a season with the Phoenix Coyotes following the relocation of the Jets. He later worked as an Asst. and Head Coach of the Ottawa Senators (2005-08) and as an Asst. Coach and Asst. GM with the Philadelphia Flyers (2009-14).

Playing career: Played for his hometown Brandon Wheat Kings (1972-74). Scored 83-points in 68-games in his second and final junior season, leading to being drafted by the Washington Capitals in the third round of the 1974 NHL draft. Went onto play parts of five seasons in the NHL split between the Philadelphia Flyers and Quebec Nordiques.

Notes: 2015 and 2017 WHL Coach of the Year...2017 WHL Executive of the Year.



Dave Struch | Head Coach & Assistant GM

Bio: From Flin Flon, Manitoba...enters his fourth year as Head Coach & Assistant GM.

Coaching: Began his coaching career with the Saskatoon Blades as an Assistant Coach (2006-07) following a 14 year professional hockey career. Held an Asst. Coach position with the Blades for seven seasons before taking over as Head Coach prior to the 2013-14 season. He later joined the Pats for the 2014-15 season as Asst. Coach before taking over as Head Coach for the 2018-19 season. Dave also was an Asst. for the 2019 Canada-Russia Series and was Head Coach for Team Canada Black at 2017 World U17 Hockey Challenge.

Playing Career: Played his junior hockey with the Saskatoon Blades (1988-92), where he totaled 285-points (134 G / 151 A) in 253-games. Was drafted in the ninth round by the Calgary Flames in the 1991 NHL draft. Went onto play four games with Flames during the 1993-94 season, as part of a 14 year pro hockey career split between the NHL, AHL, IHL and various European leagues.

Brad Herauf | Assistant Coach

Bio: Regina, SK...enters his fifth season as Assistant Coach.

Coaching Career: Started his coaching career as the Head Coach of the Regina Pat Canadians U18 AAA (2013-2015) member of Saskatchewan Midget AAA Hockey League. He joined the Pats as an Asst. Coach for the 2015-16 season. On the Bench, Brad handles the defensemen.

Playing career: Suited up for the Regina Pat Canadians U18 AAA before embarking a four year career in the SJHL split between the Estevan Bruins and Battlefords North Stars where he tallied 197-points (71 G / 126 A) in 197-games. He then went onto play 10 years of professional hockey, dressing in the AHL, ECHL, CHL and QVHL (2003-13).

Ken Schnieder | Assistant Coach

Bio: Colfax, SK (south of Regina)...born May 15, 1961 (60).

Playing Career: Began his junior hockey career with the SJHL's Weyburn Red Wings, scoring back-to-back 30+ goal seasons, totaling 69-goals and 135-points in 117 career games (1977-80). He then went onto play two seasons with the WHL's Brandon Wheat Kings (1980-82), scoring 20-goals in his first season. Schnieder then finished his career with Weyburn before attending Brandon University from 1982-1984.

Regina Pats: Hired by the Regina Pats as an Assistant Coach on September 3rd, 2021 after being a scout for the club for three seasons (2015-2019). Schnieder has coached at many different levels over the years, including guiding the Ile-des-Chenes North Stars to an Allen Cup national championship in 2003, as well as coaching the AAA U-18 Brandon Wheat Kings from 2010-14 and in 2018-19, when he led them to a provincial championship.

HISTORY

Founded in 1917 as the Regina Patricia Hockey Club, the Regina Pats have been a Queen City tradition for more than a century.

Named for the Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry, the Pats are the oldest major junior hockey franchise in the world.

The Pats are proud members of the Western Hockey League, having won WHL championships in 1974 and 1980. Along with these league championships, the Pats are four-time Memorial Cup champions, with victories in 1925, 1928 (as the Regina Monarchs), 1930, and 1974.

The Pats storied connection with the Memorial Cup owes both to the club's four championships, along with Regina's proud tradition of hosting the event. The Memorial Cup has been staged — at least in part — seven times in the Queen City (shared in 1947, 1957, 1969, 1980 and solely in 1950, 2001 and 2018). The 2018 edition celebrated the centennial of both the Memorial Cup and Pats.

Since 1977 the club has called the Brandt Centre (originally the Agridome) home, where a total of 10 numbers hang from the rafters honouring the team's very best:
