PATS SET FOR MATINEE MEETING WITH ICE

REGINA – The Regina Pats return to action Saturday night inside the Subway WHL Hub at the Brandt Centre for a meeting with the Winnipeg ICE.

Regina was off Friday, while Winnipeg picked up their seventh win of the season with a 3-0 victory over the Prince Albert Raiders.

Saturday marks the second meeting of the season with Winnipeg, as the Regiment complete their second rotation through the six opposing teams inside the Hub. The first meeting between the two teams wasn't kind to Regina, as the ICE skated away with an 8-3 decision back on March 23. That game started an up and down stretch for the Pats, who have won three games over the stretch, while suffering two lopsided losses – 7-3 vs. Saskatoon on March 26 and Regina's most recent outing, an 8-3 loss to Winnipeg Thursday.

Regina enters Saturday's game still looking for their first win over the ICE since the team relocated from the Kootenays prior to last season. The Pats went 0-3-1-1 in 2019-20 versus Winnipeg.

Following Saturday's game, which marks the midway point of the Hub schedule for Regina, the Pats will play three more games before losing Connor Bedard to Team Canada and the U18 World Championship. Bedard was named Thursday to Canada's roster for the event, which opens April 26 in Texas. The rookie phenom has 20 points in 11 games and entered the long weekend as the WHL's leading scorer.

TEAM HISTORY

Founded in 1917 as the Regina Patricia Hockey Club, the Regina Pats have been a Queen City tradition for more than a century.

Named for the Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry, the Pats are the oldest major junior hockey franchise in the world.

The Pats are proud members of the Western Hockey League, having won WHL championships in 1974 and 1980. Along with these league championships, the Pats are four-time Memorial Cup champions, with victories in 1925, 1928 (as the Regina Monarchs), 1930, and 1974.

The Pats storied connection with the Memorial Cup owes both to the club's four championships, along with Regina's proud tradition of hosting the event. The Memorial Cup has been staged — at least in part — seven times in the Queen City (shared in 1947, 1957, 1969, 1980 and solely in 1950, 2001 and 2018). The 2018 edition celebrated the centennial of both the Memorial Cup and Pats.

More than 160 Pats have gone on to play in the National Hockey League, including current NHLers Sam Steel (Anaheim Ducks | Pats 2014-18), Austin Wagner (LA Kings | Pats 2013-17), and Jordan Eberle (NY Islanders | Pats 2006-10).
